- An **increase** from 2016 results of students in Year 3 and Year 5 **meeting** the **National Minimal Standard** in NAPLAN.
- An **increased percentage** of students meeting or **exceeding** year level targets in **Reading and Number**.

Our initiatives include

Improve learning outcomes for all students by:

- 1. Improving Pedagogy**
 - Build upon the existing Professional Learning Community by supporting Professional Learning Teams through targeted, needs-based professional development that aligns with the Annual Implementation Plan.
 - Introduction of specific professional roles that build teacher professional capacity and leadership.
 - Access to specialist coaching and guided reading experts.
- 2. Consistent and Cohesive Evidence-Based Practices**
 - Revision of existing reading, number and problem-solving documents to instil a common-language throughout the school.
 - Co-ordinated curriculum planning time to ensure critical junctures across year levels are catered for within reading, number and problem-solving.
- 3. Targeted Intervention**
 - Use of data to inform targeted student intervention (support and extension) within the classroom.
 - Teacher Aide support in priority learning areas.
